Session 3: January - February

Week 1: Created to Be(Come) Like Christ

When first becoming a Christian, our knowledge of God is small, but hopefully throughout our lives we will continue to grow in Him, becoming more like Christ. We will look at a parable in Matthew and also the fruit of the Spirit. **Challenge:** What's one of the fruits should you be more or, or that is hard for you to express? *Key Passages: Matthew 13:18-23, John 15:16*

Week 2: How We Grow (More Like Christ)

Continuing off of what we learned last week, we will look at ways to become more like Christ. How do we learn how to do this? How does it look when we do become more like Christ? What are some things that we can add to our faith? **Challenge:** Memorize 2 Peter 1:5-8 *Key Passages: Hebrews 5:14, John 14:12, 2 Peter 1:5-8*

Week 3: Transformed by The Truth

This week, we will look at the importance of God's Word. We will go over how everything in it is true, and how it is intended to strengthen our faith and make us wiser. Transformation into the person God has made us to be is an ongoing process, but His Word is there to help us through this journey. *Key Passages: 2 Timothy 3:14-17, Romans 12:1-2, Philippians 3:12-14*

Week 4: Transformed By Trouble and Hardships

This week we will focus on the story of Job, and apply that to troubles and hardships that may arise in our lives. We will look at how Job handled the trials he faced, and how we can apply his attitude and faith when we are faced with issues in life. By remembering God's plan is good, rejoicing and giving thanks, and refusing to give up we can be transformed by the troubles and hardships we face. *Key Passages: The story of Job*

Week 5: Growing Through and Defeating Temptation

This week we will study the key passages to see how we are able to grow through and defeat temptations that will arise in our life. By using God's Word, we can stand strong against temptations that we will face. We can also grow from these experiences, making us stronger in our faith. **Challenge:** Make a bracelet that will help remind you to guard against temptations you face. *Key Passages: James 1:13-15, 1 Corinthians 10:12-13, Matthew 4:1-11*

Week 6: Accepting Your Assignment of Service

Sometimes it can be hard to accept the task we have been given to complete. But it is encouraging to remember that God has given each of us talents in order to complete the work He has given us. This week will hopefully encourage the students to look for ways they can use their unique gifts to serve those around them. **Challenge:** What is something you love to do? Think about how God might be calling you to reach others for Him and glorify Him through that. *Key Passages: Romans 9:20-21, John 3:27, 1 Corinthians 12, Romans 12:6*
