Chapel Session Two (November - December)

Week 1: How Do We Please/Love God?

Listening to what God tells us to do, trusting that He knows what He is doing and will take care of us and look out for our best even if it seems like He's asking us do something kind of scary. We show that we trust God when we obey what He has asked us to do. *Key Verses: Hebrews 11:5-6,8-10, John 14:15*

Week 2: Becoming Best Friends With God

Even though God is a lot different than any of our other friends – we can't physically see or touch God, most people haven't heard God's voice, He's on a completely different level than the people we are friends with, whom He created – God still desires a relationship with us that is a lot like the relationship we have with our best friends. *Key Verses: I Thessalonians 5:17, John 15:15*

Week 3: The Relationship Comes First

God's first commandment to His people established the foundation upon which all other commandments and aspects of life stand: God must be first and foremost in our lives. All other commands are founded upon loving God with our entire selves, our heart, soul, mind and strength. *Key Verses: Exodus 20:1-3, I Corinthians 13*

Week 4: Formed for God's Family

Just like all of us belong to immediate families and we have special jobs to do, if we are Christians, we belong to God's bigger family, and each of us also has a special job that God has given us to do to help His family. *Key Verses: Ephesians 2:19-22*

Week 5: Loving God by Loving His Family

How we treat and care for the members of God's family has specific importance to God. Several places in scripture confirm specifically that we love God by loving his people. *Key Verses: Hebrews 6:10-11, John 13:34-35, I John 5:1-2*
